



Weekend in ... Napa Valley, Calif.

Moderate

Getting there: Round-trip, walk-up Economy Class rates are \$456 with Delta. One-way rates from \$228 on AirTran require a 3-day advance purchase notice.

Stay: The Napa River Inn, at the historic Napa Mill, offers a "Dinner's on Us" package at rates starting at \$249 a night. Stay and receive a \$100 dining credit at any one of four select dining spots on Restaurant Row. Stay two nights and receive \$100 in dining credits each night. Guests enjoy breakfast in bed from Sweetie Pie's Bakery, evening wine tastings, nightly turndown service and WiFi; 500 Main St., Napa, 1-877-251-8500, www.napariverinn.com.

Eat: FARM, at The Carneros Inn, features an outdoor living room-style al fresco lounge, dramatic cathedral ceilings, two fireplaces and neighborhood wines. Simple yet elegant regional dishes are complemented by housemade breads, pastries and charcuterie products. Starters \$9-\$18; entrees \$24-\$46; 4048 Sonoma Hwy., Napa, 707-299-4880.

Experience: Through March, soil-nourishing wild mustard carpets area vineyards with brilliant hues of green and gold. Calistoga's 16th Annual "Mustard, Mud & Music" festival turns this relaxed and walkable Napa Valley town into a big jazz club. The March 5 event features live music, wine tasting, an art show, and mustard-inspired dishes prepared by local chefs.
